For APA, you use the authors' surnames only and the year of publication in text. If you are using a direct quote, you will also need to use a page number. If you are using the authors' names as part of the sentence, normal sentence rules apply - always use "and", and never us an "&".

In-text citations - APA (6th Edition) Referencing Guide ...

The APA style calls for three kinds of information to be included in in-text citations. The author's last name and the work's date of publication must always appear, and these items must match exactly the corresponding entry in the references list. The third kind of information, the page number, appears only in a citation to a direct quotation.

Note: All citations should be double spaced and have a hanging indent in a Reference List. A "hanging indent" means that each subsequent line after the first line of your citation should be indented by 0.5 inches. How to cite the APA manual in APA format - Quora

When there is no author your in-text and parenthetical citations should begin with the first couple words of the title and include the year of publication. When citing books, videos, brochures, journals, reports, etc. italicize the title. When citing web pages, journal article titles, or chapter titles use quotation marks around the title.
